

Florian B. Lagler MD PhD, is board certified paediatrician and board certified pharmacologist and toxicologist. He is currently Head of the Institute for Inherited Metabolic Diseases of Paracelsus Medical University Salzburg and CEO of the Clinical Research Centre Salzburg GmbH.

In his clinic he sees patients with Fabry disease, Gaucher disease, Pompe disease, MPS and other LSDs. As a clinical and translational researcher he works on treatment innovations and improvements for lysosomal storage diseases (LSD) and other inborn errors of metabolism (IEM).

He serves as an advisor for the Austrian Agency for Health and Food Safety (AGES), as a drug commissioner in the German Society for Children and Youth Medicine and as editor of *Monatsschrift Kinderheilkunde*, the Organ of German and Austrian Society of Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine.

Moreover Dr. Lagler leads the Medical Simulation Centre Salzburg. Together with an international faculty of LSD and emergency medicine experts he developed specific simulation trainings for physicians and nurses that take care for patients with lysosomal storage diseases. Meanwhile these unique trainings have been provided to more than 350 nurses and physicians from more than 30 countries all over the world.
