

Professor Elisabeth Fertl, born 1963, is the Head of the neurological department of Krankenanstalt Rudolfstiftung in Vienna, Austria. This hospital is an academic teaching hospital of the Medical University of Vienna and one of the six main public hospitals of Vienna. In Rudolfstiftung hospital the local neurological services are acute stroke management including an intervention center for endovascular stroke treatment, a large multiple sclerosis center and an emergency service for all acute neurological diseases. There also exist tight cooperations with the local departments of neurosurgery, neuroradiology, and intensive care. She holds diploma of several neurophysiological trainings. Her initial research targeted psychosocial outcomes in neurorehabilitation, her actual research focuses in stroke management and neuroimmunological disorders. She was part of the program committee of the 21st World Congress of Neurology in 2013 in Vienna, Austria. Since 2013 she has been a member of the national health advisory panel of Austria, since 2016 she serves as president of the Austrian society of Neurology. Starting with 2018, she has been appointed as the national institutional delegate for the European Academy of Neurology.
